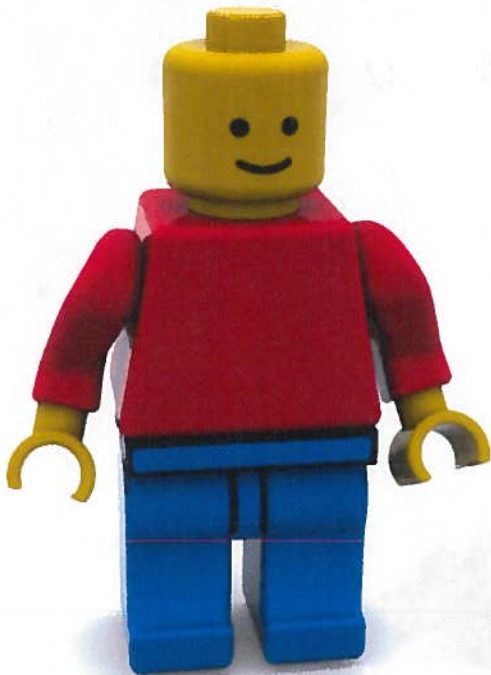

## The History of Lego Toys

The company that makes the little, plastic bricks known as Lego started in a small shop in Denmark. The inventor was Ole Kirk Christiansen. The word Lego means “play well”.

In 1960, Lego was international and was selling Lego toys in countries like Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom, France, Belgium and Germany.

For the first time, in 1964, people could buy Lego sets with all of the parts and instructions to build a particular model. After, Lego introduced themed lines like space (1979), pirates (1989), Star Wars (1999) and Harry Potter (2001).

For many years now, Lego toys have sparked the imagination of kids around the world and are one of the world’s most popular toys.
